SOLO DIVER



One of our most popular courses, the solo diver program teaches experienced recreational divers how to safely dive independently of a dive buddy or strengthen your buddy team skills. The course stresses on proper dive planning, personal limitations, accident prevention as well as the benefits, hazards, and proper procedures for diving solo. You will also learn the additional equipment that is required for solo diving including it's proper usage and assembly. This is the perfect course for spearfisherman and divers who typically dive more than 100 feet deep off the North Carolina Coast.

Requirements include Classroom sessions and Two Boat Dives.

Prerequisites: 100 logged dives; Deep and Wreck Specialties or Advanced Specialty

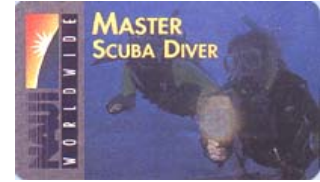

Scuba diving from boats is an everyday occurrence, especially in North Carolina. Whether on a private vessel or one of the many charter dive boats available worldwide, divers are frequently not aware of the special procedures and etiquette used when boat diving. The SDI Boat Diver course will introduce you to some different types of boat diving and the skills needed to plan and conduct a boat dive with maximum safety. The list of skills and knowledge you will obtain during this course is long and includes:

- Safe entries and exits
- Proper stowing of equipment
- Safety procedures
- Emergency procedures
- Planning boat dives
- Drift diving from live boats

Class consists of one academic session and two dives where you put to use the valuable information you have learned. Call Shop For Specific Dates. Typically this class is offered one weeknight before each scheduled dive charter.
